The *Golden Rule* is on a 15-month voyage down the Mississippi, around the Gulf Coast, up the east coast of the US and through the Great Lakes making 100 ports-of-call to raise awareness about the growing danger of nuclear war and to build support for the abolition of nuclear weapons. It is a national project of Veterans For Peace, which owns the boat.
