The historic 39-foot sailboat "Golden Rule" is sailing the coast of New England during June to alert us to the need for a world without nuclear weapons.

In 1958, an intrepid crew of Quaker peace activists sailed the Golden Rule to the South Pacific to try to "get in the way" of massive nuclear tests the U.S. was planning there. They were arrested in Honolulu, but they left a lasting legacy.

Now, a new crew from Veterans for Peace is using this memorable ship to campaign against the madness of nuclear weapons.
