In 1958, an intrepid crew of Quakers sailed the small ship 'Golden Rule' to the South Pacific, to try to block massive nuclear weapons tests the USA was planning there. They were arrested in Honolulu, but they created a lasting legacy. Now a new crew from Veterans for Peace is using the very same ship to highlight threats posed by these weapons and to promote the exciting new UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.
